DIRECTIONS: TO CONTROL RATS

Spread 2 level teaspoonsful of paste on slices of bread weighing about one ounce each. Make a sandwich of two of these slices of bread on which the paste has been spread. Press the sandwich together firmly, and cut into 1/2 inch squares. Use one square as a bait. Cubed or chunk style baits will be carried by rodents from otherwise safe placements. Place baits in 1/2 inch mesh closed, wire baskets that are securely anchored. Stephenson's Phosphorus Paste may also be mixed with fresh ground meat or fish, or canned salmon. Use two tablespoonsful of paste to a pound of bait, or one pound of paste to nine pounds of bait. Distribute baits in teaspoonful quantities.
