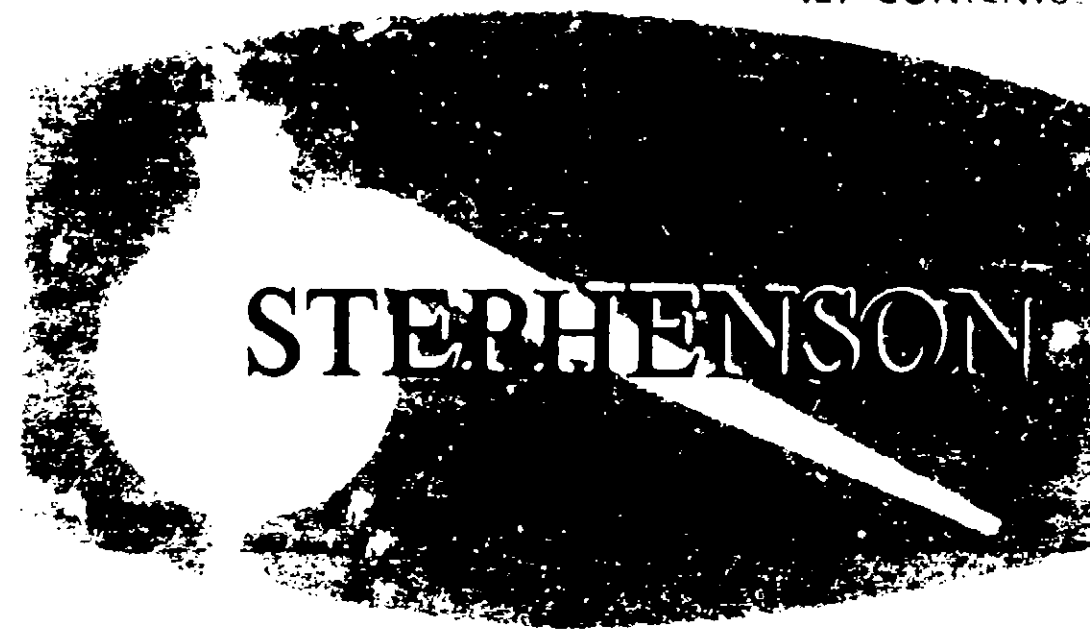

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Crawling Insects:

For best application for an initial clean-up, use a .25% solution and apply in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine spray, using approximately 1 gallon of diluted material to each 750 sq. ft. of surface. Against roaches, spiders, earwigs, centipedes, grain mites, and sowbugs use this oil-diluted concentrate, spray thoroughly all surfaces and areas where these insects are usually found, including walls, baseboards, moldings, floors, cabinets, shelves, sinks, and pipes, with special attention to cracks, crevices, niches, dark corners, drains, and similar hiding places. For ants, treat ant trails, runs, and nests. Repeat treatment using a .15% solution at the same rate of application after an interval of 3 to 4 weeks or as needed.

Wasps and Hornets: (for indoor use only):

Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Using a .250% solution, thoroughly spray into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. See dilution chart for a .25% solution.

Flying Insects (except Wasps and Hornets)

For rapid control of moths, flies, gnats, and mosquitos, use a .056% solution and apply in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Direct the diluted spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure, filling the room with the mist, and using approx. 2 oz. of dilute material for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Whenever practicable, keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after application. Do not remain in treated area, and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

DO NOT FOG OR SPRAY NEAR OPEN FLAME.

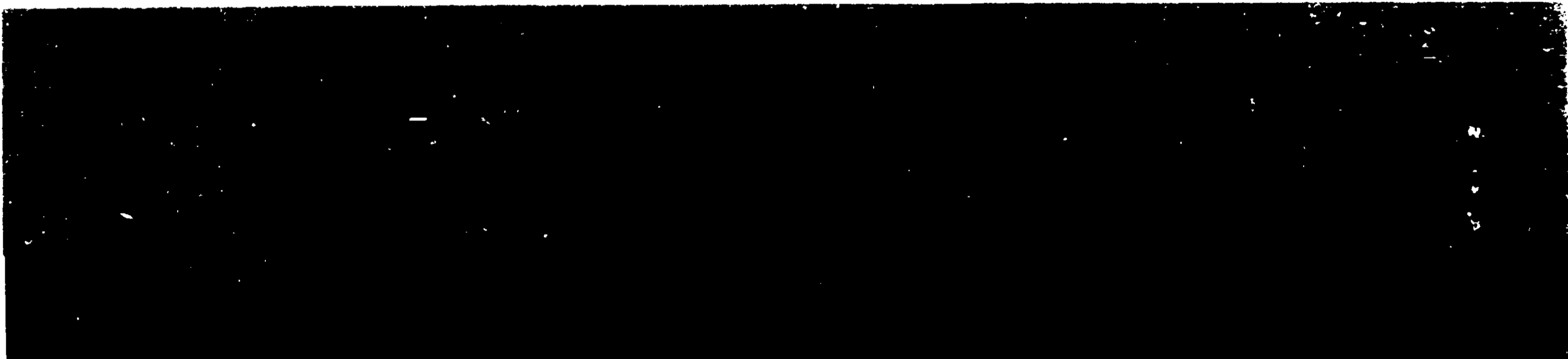
