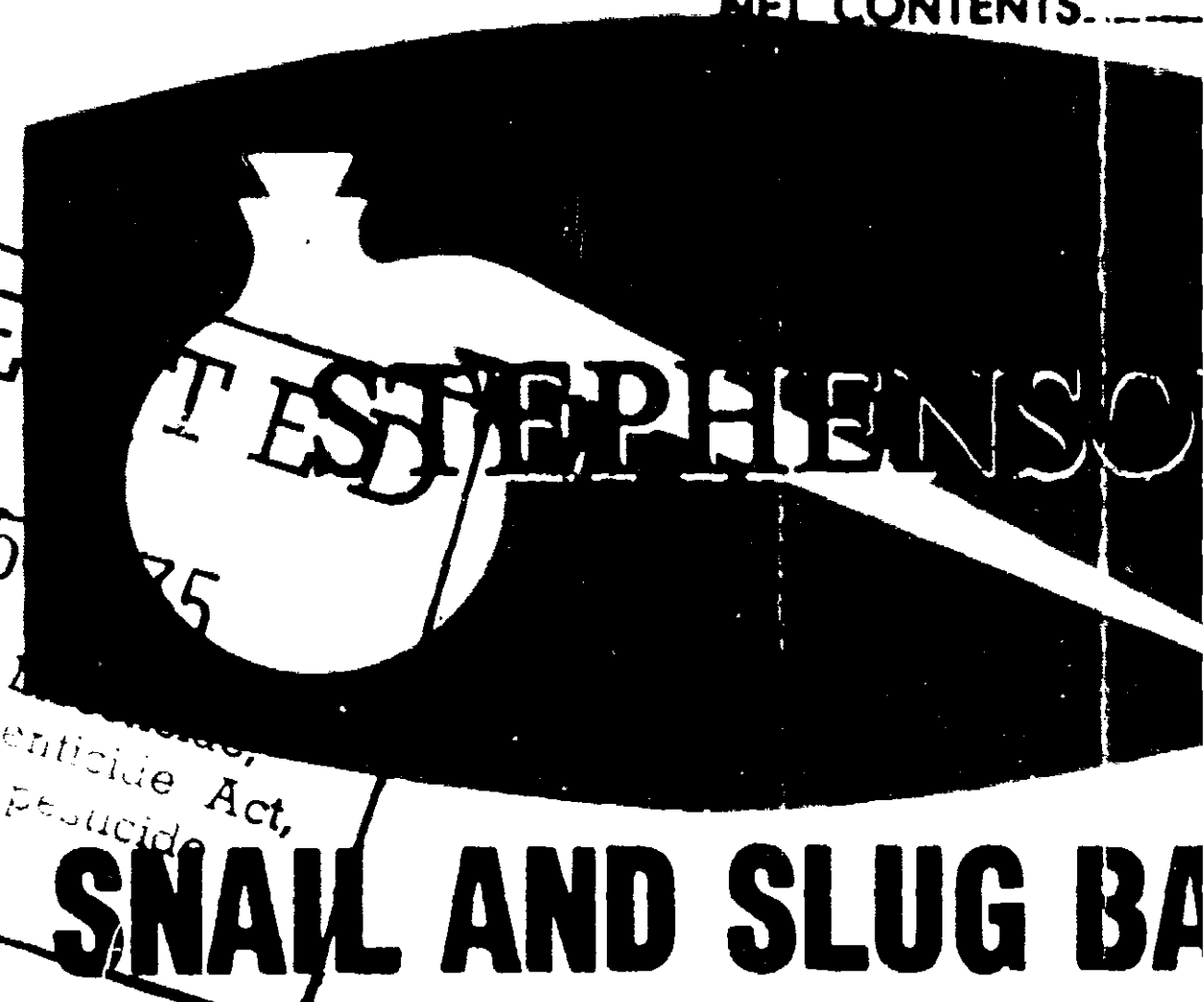

When making applications, special attention should be given to treating areas around flower beds, under greenhouse benches and around building foundations. Repeat application as necessary to maintain control.

Do not use on plants grown for food. Do not put bait in piles. Scatter bait so that it is hardly visible on the ground.

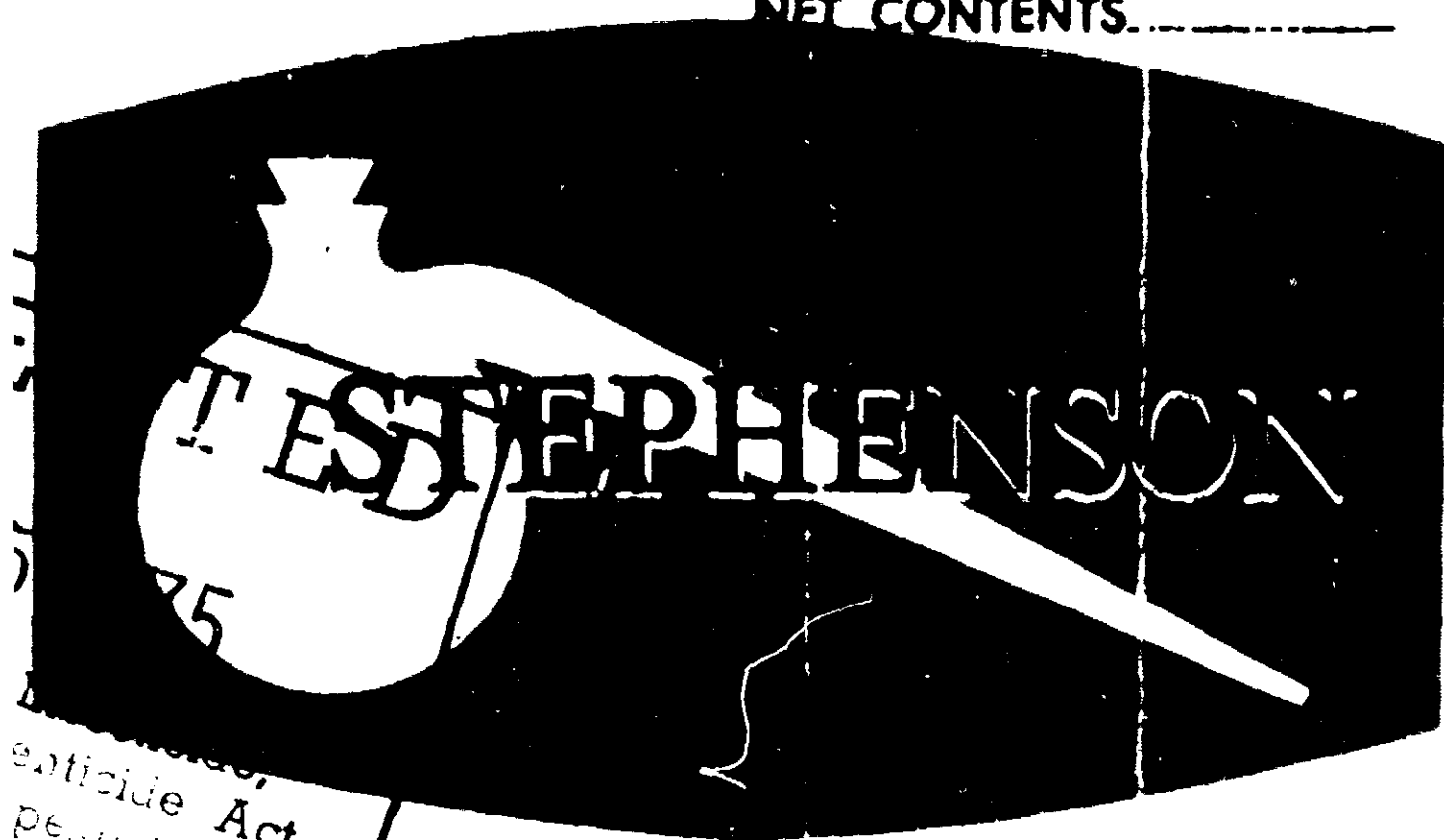
