DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LAWN AND TURF AREAS:

To control chinch bugs, sod webworms, ants, brown dog ticks, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, and sawbugs, uniformly apply this product at the rate of 25 pounds per 6000 sq. ft. (1/4 lb. to 64 sq. ft.) to non-crop turf grass areas using any hand or power-operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear; re-treat as necessary. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, thoroughly water the treated turf to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.

To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use 25 to 50 pounds of this product per 2500 sq. ft. (1/4 lb. to 25-50 sq. ft.). Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thoroughly watering to wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils, uniformly apply 50 pounds of granules per 6000 sq. ft. (1/4 lb. to 25 sq. ft.) as directed above. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialists for best time to treat in your area. Do not apply to Dichondria.

OUTSIDE HOUSES & INDUSTRIAL BUILDINGS:

For control of ants, crickets, earwigs and brown dog ticks, apply in a 5-foot band around the foundation at the rate of 1/2 lb. per 100 sq. ft. (5' x 20 ft.). Distribute granules uniformly.
