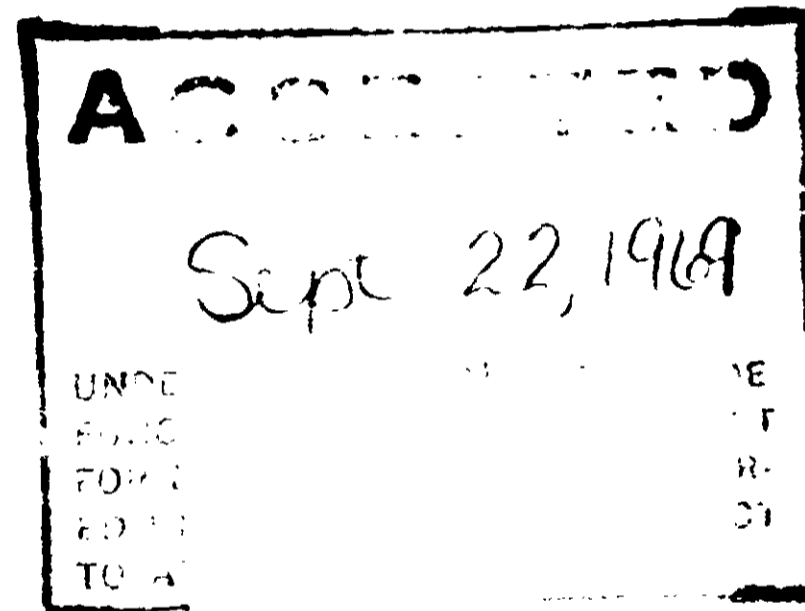

If exposed to air, contents will crystallize slightly. In that case, add a small amount of scalding water. Use correspondingly more.

If packed in metal container place contents in a glass container immediately upon receipt.

DIRECTIONS

BEEF CATTLE, DAIRY CATTLE: Mange (Sarcoptic Mites), Scab (Psoroptic Mites, Chorioptic Mites). 6 2/3 gallons per 100 gallons of water at 95° to 105° Fahrenheit. Apply as a vat dip for 2 to 3 minutes at intervals of 10 to 14 days.

SHEEP: Scab (Psoroptic Mites, Chorioptic Mites). 6 2/3 gallons per 100 gallons of water at 95° to 105° Fahrenheit. Apply as a vat dip for 2 to 3 minutes at intervals of 10 to 14 days.

CAUTION: May cause skin irritation. If irritation is observed on small or young animals with tender skin, discontinue use until symptoms disappear.
