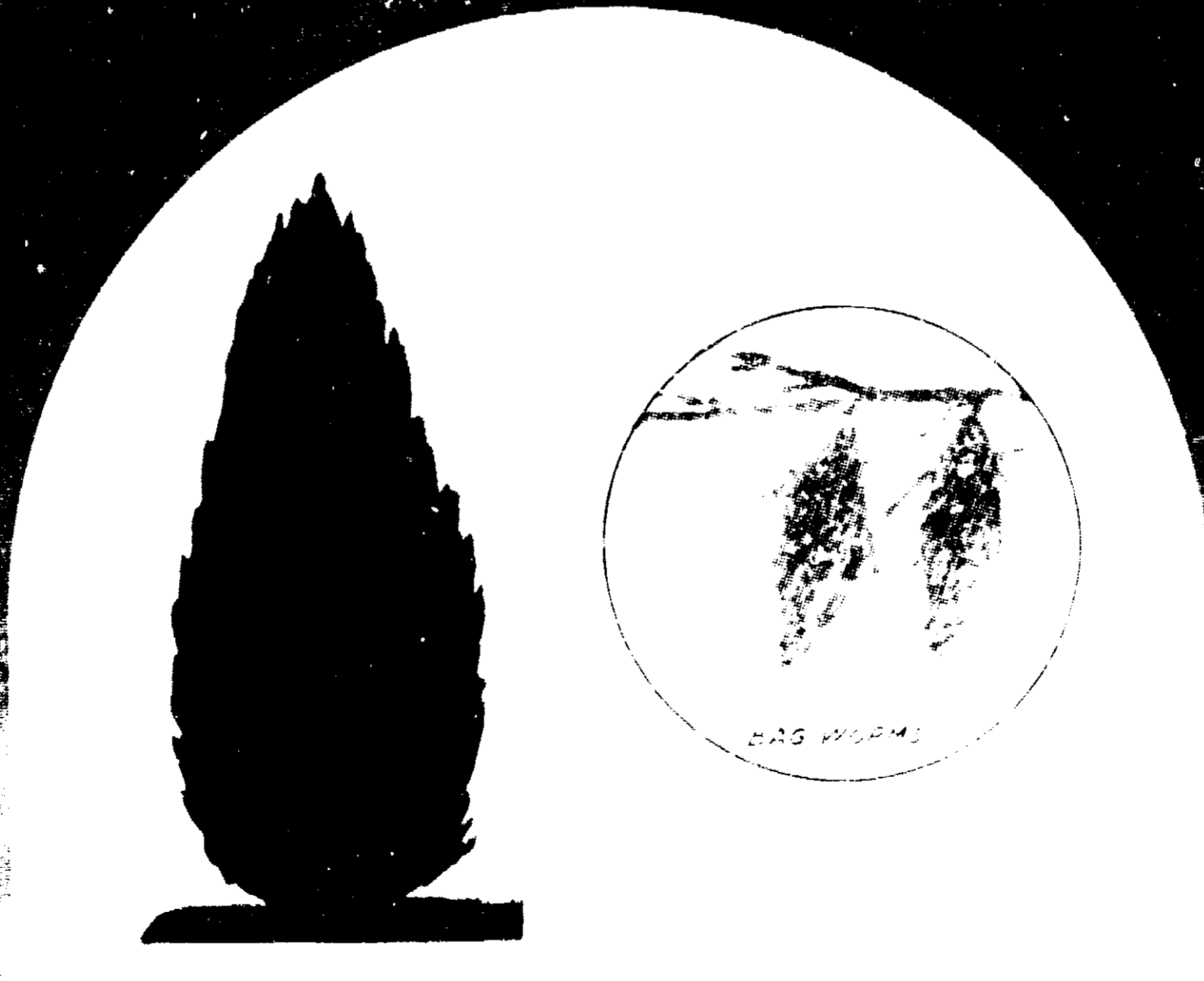




# BAG WORM SPRAY

# BAG WORM SPRAY

To control mites, spray trees twice monthly throughout the growing season as required.

## CAUTION:

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing of spray mist or dust. May cause irritation of nose, throat and skin. In case of contact, wash with warm water and soap. For eyes, get medical attention. Store away from children and domestic animals. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs. In case of swallowing, call doctor immediately, then administer an emetic such as 1 tablespoonful of mustard, or 1 tablespoonful salt in a glass of warm water, to induce vomiting. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear.

Contamination of ornamental ponds will be harmful to fish.

Do not use on forage crops to be fed to dairy animals or those being finished for slaughter.

Toxaphene (technical chlorinated camphene) 15.00%  
(chlorine content 67% to 69%)

\*2-(p-tert-butylphenoxy)-1-methylethyl  
2-chloroethyl sulphite 0.90%

\*The ingredient 2-(p-tert-butylphenoxy)-1-methylethyl 2-chloroethyl sulfate is otherwise known as "ARAMITE".

## BAG WORM SPRAY:

Kills bag worms and mites.

## SPRAYING INSTRUCTIONS:

BAG WORM SPRAY should be used only on evergreens to control BAG WORMS and European Red Spruce and Two-Spotted Mites. DO NOT SPRAY fruit trees or any edible crop with this product.

## PREPARING SPRAY MIXTURE:

Use one pound of BAG WORM SPRAY in 4 gallons of water. To avoid nozzle stoppage of sprayer, be sure to blend the mixture with just enough water to form a thick cream, stirring thoroughly and, shortly thereafter, add the proper amount of water in sprayer.

4 tablespoonfuls approximately 1 1/2 oz.

## GOOD-LIFE BAG WORM SPRAY:

For best results and to avoid as much winter injury to evergreens as possible, spray your trees before the worms develop. This is in any late May and early June.
