To kill sucking insects such as Aphids, Rose Scale, Two Spotted Spider Mites, Rose Leaf Hopper. To kill leaf eating insects such as Rose Chafer, Rose Leaf Beetle, Rose Slugs, Thrips, Rose Midge, Japanese Beetle and certain other leaf eating insects.

**DIRECTIONS:**

Start spraying roses in early spring as soon as leaves are out. It is always better to prevent disease than to cure it and insects are eliminated more effectively when young and before they have an opportunity to damage the plant.


Use 4 tablespoonsful (2 ounces) of **GOOD-LIFE ROSE SPRAY LIQUID** in 1 gallon of water. It is suggested that one half of the water be poured into the sprayer, add the **ROSE LIQUID**, shake thoroughly and then add the balance of the water, mixing thoroughly before spraying. When using a garden hose spray, please follow sprayer directions to apply at a rate of 4 tablespoonsful or 2 ounces per gallon of water.

Roses should be sprayed once a week, being sure to thoroughly wet foliage, both top and underside of leaves. When rain washes spray residue from plant, make a fresh application as soon as foliage is dry.

It is best to spray early morning or late evening to avoid temperature above 90° F. and bright sunshine.
