

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Pour specified amount of this product into nearly filled spray tank. Add balance of water to fill tank. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations.

TERMITES - Mix 2 to 4 qts. in 100 gal. water. Apply at the rate of 4 gal. per 10 linear foot for each foot of depth to a trench dug next to the foundation 1 to 2 feet deep and 8 inches wide. For buildings with deep footings, dig trench 30 inches deep. Do not dig trench below the level of the footing.
