

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

How to apply

1. Be sure soil is moist and lawn healthy before treating. Discoloration will appear several days in advance and restore full green color after treating.

2. Keep lawn mowed to 1 1/2 to 2 inches during treatment.

3. Flush sprayer thoroughly with water after using.

4. Lawn may discolor from treatment. Discolorations are temporary and grasses will soon return to normal.

Note: Good-Life Crab-No Crabgrass kills crabgrass seedlings and young plants. Rates of application in the presence of weeds, such as Yellow Pines and Tansy grasses. Possible injury may occur to grasses. In August, a dry and hot weather may cause discoloration of the lawn. Crabgrass seedlings and young plants may be killed. This will require several treatments. Crabgrass seedlings and young plants will be killed.

Do not apply to newly seeded lawn.

WARNING: May be harmful to fish and aquatic life. Avoid contact with fish and aquatic life.

Store Beyond reach of children. Use only as directed.

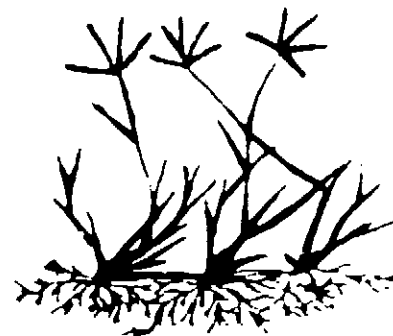

Crabgrass can be controlled by any of the methods below. Use the first if possible, to avoid any chance of discoloration of lawn.

1. **Young Crabgrass:** In early spring, when crabgrass seedlings are visible, apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet. If crabgrass is not visible, apply 1/4 pint per 100 square feet. Repeat applications may be necessary if crabgrass appears later in the season. For crabgrass, apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet.

2. **Branching Crabgrass:** Apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet. Repeat applications may be necessary if crabgrass appears later in the season. For crabgrass, apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet.

3. **Lawns completely overrun with Crabgrass, and Seed Heads are visible:** Apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet. Repeat applications may be necessary if crabgrass appears later in the season. For crabgrass, apply 1/2 pint per 100 square feet.

WARNING: Keep children and pets off treated areas.

How to apply

A. With nozzle type sprayer which attaches to garden hose. Mix 1/2 pint of product with 100 gallons of water. Spray evenly over the lawn.

B. With pressure sprayer. Mix 1/2 pint of product with 100 gallons of water. Spray evenly over the lawn.

C. With watering can. Mix 1/2 pint of product with 100 gallons of water. Water evenly over the lawn.
