

SPRAY APPLICATION: Mix amount given with enough water to form a paste. Stir until mixture is smooth and creamy, then dilute with water and pour into sprayer. Mix thoroughly and agitate while spraying to avoid settling of material. Use diluted mixture with good pressure to insure thorough coverage of top and underside of foliage.

AMOUNTS TO USE-DUST APPLICATION-16 level tablespoonfuls per 200 sq. ft. On strawberries and peas, use one half this amount. SPRAY APPLICATION 4 oz. to 1 gal. water per 200 sq. ft.
