PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DUMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Chuses irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vorwting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention, Remove and wash ell contaminated clothing before reuse.

Concentrate may be used in the manufacti : of sanitizers and disinfectants that do not require , rising after being adequately drained from food contact surfaces at concentrations not exceeding 25 ppm titratable rodine (refer to Federal Regulation No. 121,2547). To meet this requirement, all components used in the finished formulation must also comply with Food and Drug Administration no-rinsed regulations. Animicrobials intended for topical application to humans and animals must be approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

NOTE TO FORMULATOR: Mix well in drum before sumpling and before ser hiuse.

Clean Front will flow and mix more sesily if a day or two prior to formulating it is gradually warmed to 70°F to 100°F and then slowly added in a thin stream while mixing,

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store below 25°F or above 100°F for extended periods.

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
