

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to revise your label per PR Notice 2000-3 will be acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release this product for shipment bearing the amended label.

- 1. Under the "First Aid Statement" revise the "If Swallowed" to read:
  - o Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
  - o Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
  - O Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
  - o Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- 2. For Toxicity Category I eye and skin irritants, use the following "Note to Physician".

"Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."
