FIRST AID	
If in Eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes. Then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
If Swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything to an unconscious person.
If on Skin or Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
If Inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-424-9300 for emergency treatment information.	
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.	

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Store at room temperature (59°-86°F). Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: In case of spill flood area with large quantity of water, washing to sewer or collection vessel. Waste resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner, then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in same manner.
