## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Sterage: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store below 25° F or above 100° F for extended periods.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment. In case of spill, flood area with large quantity of water, washing to sewer or collection vessel.

Watter resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse, puncture, and dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration.

Danger: Causes eye damage and skin irritation: Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swellowed. Avoid contemination of feed.

First aid: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician, Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.


