**GLASSES AND DISHES**

**Three-Sink System:**

To preclean, wash glasses and dishes contain one ounce of GLADISH CLEANER of cold or lukewarm (not hot) water.

Rinse in clear water in Sink No. 2, where Place cleaned glasses and dishes in Sink one ounce of GLADISH CLEANER/SANITIZER or lukewarm (not hot) water. This solution iodine. Allow to soak for one minute. Remove to drain and air-dry.

**Two-Sink System: (where permitted)**
