Dear Mr. Beach:

This is in response to your resubmission of a revised Confidential Statement of Formula(CSF) and labeling. The following comments apply.

The revised updated basic CSF and the alternate CSF dated July 27, 1993 are in compliance with PR Notice 91-2. They agree with the label claim and the nominal concentration and are acceptable.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit five copies of the finished label before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Since the flash point of the product is between 80⁰ C and 150⁰ C the label should have the following fire hazard caution placed below the Physical and Chemical Hazards heading: "Do not use or store near heat or open flame".
2. Delete the words "General Classification" from under the "Directions For Use" heading.
3. In the "First Aid" section under "If swallowed", delete "promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available,".

4. Change the statement "For Dairy Farm and Food Sanitation" to read "For Dairy Farm and Food-Use Surface Sanitization".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.



All surfaces should be cleaned and rinsed before sanitizing with Acidet. At a use dilution of 1 oz. to 5 gallons of water, Acidet provides 230 ppm of dodecylbenzenesulfonic acid.

FARM USE:

For Milk Claws and Inflatons: Clean with a suitable detergent and rinse with potable water. Flush an Acidet solution of 1 oz. to 5 gal. of water through the system. Do not recirculate. Be sure the solution is in contact with food-use surfaces for 1 to 2 minutes. Drain the solution thoroughly.

Hand Utensils: Scrape or preclean dirty utensils. Clean using Super Kleenite™ Manual Cleaner, following label directions. Rinse with potable water. Soak or spray utensils/inflatons with Acidet solution (1 oz./5 gal. of water). After 1 to 2 minutes contact time, drain solution thoroughly. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if the solution becomes soiled or dirty.

Bulk Milk Tanks: Clean tank with Dynemate® Cleaner, and rinse with potable water. Manually spray an Acidet solution (1 oz./5 gal. of water) on all surfaces to be sanitized. After 1 to 2 minutes contact time, drain solution thoroughly.

FOOD PLANT USE:

Bulk Tanks, Vats and Utensils: Scrape or preclean dirty surfaces. Wash equipment with Dynemate® Cleaner, and rinse with potable water. Sanitize with Acidet solution (1 oz./5 gal. of water) by either brush, soak or spray method. After 1 to 2 minutes contact time drain solution thoroughly.

Follow State and local Health Department Regulations covering cleaning and sanitizing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
