This is in response to your resubmission of a revised Confidential Statement of Formula(CSF) and labeling. The following comments apply.

The revised updated basic CSF and the alternate CSF dated July 27, 1993 are in compliance with PR Notice 91-2. They agree with the label claim and the nominal concentration and are acceptable.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit five copies of the finished label before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Since the flash point of the product is between  $80^0$  C and 150<sup>0</sup> C the label should have the following fire hazard caution placed below the Physical and Chemical Hazards heading: "Do not use or store near heat or open flame".

Delete the words "General Classification" from under the 2. "Directions For Use" heading.

In the "First Aid" section under "If swallowed", delete 3. "promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available,".

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

#### GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.



All surfaces should be cleaned and rinsed before sanitizing with Acidet. At a use dilution of 1 oz. to 5 gallons of water, Acidet provides 230 ppm of dodecylbenzenesulfonic acid.

### FARM USE:
