The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to revise your label per PR Notice 2000-3 is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release this product for shipment bearing the amended label.

- Under the "Environmental Hazards Statement" revise the first sentence to read: "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms" and delete "Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams".
- Under the "Directions for Use" - Sanitizing - revise the last sentence "No potable water rinse is required" to read: "Do not rinse with potable water".
- Align the "Ingredient Statement" to read:

 (Oxyethylene)-iodine complex  
 (Providing 1.75% titratable iodine) ..... 18.05%  
 Inert Ingredients ..... 81.95%

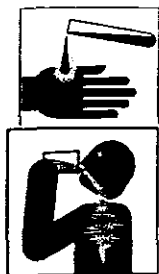

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**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**



**DANGER.** Corrosive. Causes eye damage and irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not breath spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

**FIRST AID**

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes. Then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF ON SKIN:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Hand Sanitizing** - In food handling and meat cutting operations: Wash hands thoroughly with soap and potable water, rinse and immerse hands in a 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 5 gallons of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

**Retort Cooling Water** - For canning operations: Add 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 5 to 10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

**Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization** - 1 oz. I-DYNE DISINFECTANT per 10 gallons of drinking water.

**Shoe Bath Sanitizer:** To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of I-DYNE DISINFECTANT for 30 seconds prior to entering area.
