DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR SPOT APPLICATION ONLY

GENERAL: Dursban with synergized pyrethrum insecticide used as a spot treatment to control cockroaches silverfish, spiders and other pests specified below. Using a suitable sprayer, apply as a coarse (large droplet) spray to localized areas where pests may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Re-treat as needed.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS AND SOWBUGS: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, in and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
