Place a few drops of "Ant-Kil" wherever ants are seen, and in mouth of ant hills. Ants will carry bait to nests. Repeat as needed, or twice monthly as preventative.

For Grease Feeding Ants

Mix one or two drops of salad oil with a few drops of "Ant-Kil" and place wherever ants are seen.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
