DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

For use as a contact insecticide for the control of fleas on dogs and cats. Do not use on birds or livestock.

DIRECTIONS:

In Pressurized Tank Sprayers or Machine Trigger Sprayers: Use the listed insecticide at a rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet of surface area.

To Kill Fleas in Carpets and Rugs: First vacuum carpet or rug to be treated thoroughly. Be sure to discard contents of vacuum cleaner in such a manner as to prevent recontamination. Spray surface to slight dampness. Do not saturate. Spray with a sweeping pattern back and forth 18" to 24" above area to be treated to insure complete coverage. Spray along baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and focal areas of floor. Open windows and allow to air dry for at least two hours. Do not use on upholstered furniture.

Keep All Children, Adults and Pets out of area until completely dry. Re vacuum treated area after carpet or rug is dry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

For Pet Areas and Sleeping Quarters: Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and focal areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not use on areas where food processing, preparation, food storage, feeding, or animal husbandry takes place. Cover food processing surfaces and animal sleeping quarters during treatment, or thoroughly wash them after use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Do not use on areas where food is prepared before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Do not store near heat or open flames.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flames. Do not use empty container. Wrap container and dispose of as waste.
