respiration if indicated.

**If on Skin:** Wash area immediately with soap  
and water.

**If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water and get  
prompt medical attention.

**TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH,  
SPIDERS, SOWBUGS:** Spray areas where these pests are found  
or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks  
and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window  
frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and  
cabinets, in and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility  
installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed  
directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows  
and pipes and cracks. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS:** Thoroughly apply as  
a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting  
quarters, nearby cracks and crevices along and behind base-  
boards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and  
floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding  
should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after  
treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. To control the  
source of your flea infestation, treat pets with a product registered  
for animal application.

**FLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** Use any out-of-doors as an aid in  
reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of  
windows and door frames as well as other areas where these pests  
may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting  
areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where  
these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to  
rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when  
necessary.
