Don's D-K2 Concentrated Do It Yourself Bug Killer

Your Application Dated December 13, 1996

Dear Mr. Tovey:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, add the following directions:

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

2. Revise the Environmental Hazards section to:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of equipment washwaters.

3. Revise the Physical and Chemical Hazards section to:

Do not use, spill or store near heat or open flames.
Do not spray in air in room or use on plants.

4. Add a Storage and Disposal section:

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping prohibited.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal: Reseal container and offer for reconditioning, or triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state or local procedures.

5. In the ingredients statement, remove "Petroleum distillate" from the list of active ingredients. The total of the inert ingredients should be 91.83%. Add a footnote to the ingredients statement: "Contains petroleum distillate."

Revise the existing footnote to "Consists of 0.80% (butylcarbityl)(6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.20% related compounds."

6. Revise the first complete paragraph in the Directions for Use to:

GENERAL: This is a concentrated formula. Mix only enough for immediate use. Mix one part to nine parts (one ounce to nine ounces) of water. Shake vigorously for at least one minute. Re-mix frequently during use. Baygon with synergized pyrethrins is a formulation to be used as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, ants, spiders, and other pests specified hereon. Apply as a coarse spray (large droplet) to localized areas where pests may occur. Spray surface until wet. Retreat as needed. Do not apply this product using a trigger spray pump sprayer.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

You have correctly deleted the phrase from the name of the product as it appears on the label. Our files, however, continue to show the official name of record for the product with the phrase "Do It Yourself" included.
