The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Change references to "roaches" so they read, "German roaches." A general roach claim requires additional data.
- Under the Directions for Use, delete the statement "Do not use as a coarse spray."
- Under the Directions for Use, add the following statements:
 - o Do not apply as a landscape treatment to lawns, shrubs, trees, or garden plants.
 - o Do not use as a space spray.
- Under the Storage and Disposal section, move the instructions for Pesticide Storage above Pesticide Disposal.


Approval of this labeling amendment does not constitute approval of your application for reregistration of this product. Product reregistration is currently pending and future labeling amendments and/or additional data may be required.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. The following provisions apply to existing stocks:

- If you formulate your end-use product with technical product purchased prior to January 31, 2009 that IS NOT labeled with the prohibition on indoor residential spray use, then you may label your product with existing stocks for up to 12 months after the date of this amendment letter.
- If you formulate your end-use product with technical product purchased prior to January 31, 2009 that IS labeled with the prohibition on indoor residential spray use, then you may not use existing stocks of labels that allow for indoor residential use. You must use the new, stamped label that is enclosed with this amendment letter.
- If you formulate your end-use product with technical product purchased after January 31, 2009, then you may not use existing stocks of labels that allow for indoor residential use. You must use the new, stamped label that is enclosed with this amendment letter.

FIRST AID

This is a concentrated formula. Mix only enough for immediate use. Mix one part to nine parts (one ounce to nine ounces) of water. Shake vigorously for at least one minute. Re-mix frequently during use. Baygon with synergized pyrethrins is a formulation to be used as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, ants (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants), spiders (excluding brown recluse spiders), and other pests specified hereon. Apply as a coarse spray (large droplet) to localized areas where pests may occur. Spray surface until wet. Retreat as needed. Do not apply this product using a trigger spray pump sprayer.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants), CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS (excluding brown recluse spiders), SOWBUGS: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, in and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and pipes and cracks. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: For use in kennels. Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as animal beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. To control the source of your flea infestation, treat pets with a product registered for animal application.

Will only kill pests present at the time of application. Pests must be directly contacted to be effective. Contact as many pests as possible.
