DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT UNLESS YOU HAVE READ ALL OF THE DIRECTIONS.

GENERAL: Spray surface to be treated in unoccupied areas only, away from people. Use only as for spot treatment.

TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS AND EARWIGGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, and places where these insects hide. Spray around refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and around other areas where insects are possible. For ants, spray in kitchen premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not place in animal quarters after spray.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES AND DERMAPTERID: Spray edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Inhalation of aerosol spray mist and contact with skin, eyes and clothing should be avoided. After handling, do not use in eating or drinking areas, or other areas where food is consumed. Do not use in sleeping areas where food is consumed. If poisoning occurs, get medical attention immediately.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Treat symptomatically.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL

Do not use, spill or store near heat or open flame. Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire or open flame. Exposure to temperature extremes may cause container to rupture.
