PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read all directions before using this product.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not spray in enclosed areas. (For sprays or aerosols only.)

Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.

Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face.

Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

To repel the listed insects, apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray into hands and rub on. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
