The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the final printed labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

As per the phone conversations with Daphne Waldo, it appears that the compound benzyl alcohol was inadvertently listed as an active ingredient on the label for the product cited above, and that Protexall Products, Inc. has no intention of supporting benzyl alcohol as an active ingredient through the reregistration process.

Directions for Use:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

- Apply undiluted to hair and scalp or any other infested areas until entirely wet. Do not use on eyelashes or eyebrows.
- Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer.
- Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap.
- Dead lice and eggs may require removal with a fine comb.
- Do not exceed two consecutive applications within 24 hours.
- To help eliminate infestation it is important to sterilize all clothing and bedding of infested person at time of treatment.

Use Precautions: This product is for external use only.

WARNING: Should not be used by registered controlled persons.
