DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To Spray: Hold dispenser upright with opening on side of cap away from person. Press top of cap to release mist. Keep 3 feet away from objects to avoid staining. Close doors and windows. Flying Insects: Spray towards center of insect with a circular motion. It is not necessary to spray insects directly. For average 10 x 10 x 10 room spray 6 to 8 seconds for flies, mosquitoes, flying moths and gnats; hornets and wasps 15 seconds. Keep room closed for 30 minutes after spraying. Crawling Insects: Roaches, water bugs, silverfish, fleas, ants, spiders. Direct mist into cracks, crevices and under objects.

Also spray around doors & windows. Keep room closed at least 3 hours for best results. Repeat as needed.

Moths: Clean and brush woolen materials. Spray thoroughly all articles to be protected, keeping nozzle 3 feet away to avoid staining. Spray inside closets and containers thoroughly before storing. Articles not kept in moth tight containers should be treated monthly. Bed Bugs: Spray thoroughly the dismantled spring mattress, and frame, giving special attention to all cracks and seams. Baseboards and wall cracks should also be sprayed.

HARGATE Natural Ingredient Insecticide may be used on the skin of humans & warm-blooded animals.

To control fleas, lice, on dogs, cats, birds, or flies, gnats on horses: Spray into base of hair or feathers all over animal or fowl. Also apply liberally to floor areas & sleeping quarters of animals. Spray ticks directly. Repeat all applications as needed. For human lice: Spray into hair & skin, thoroughly covering infested areas. Repeat as required.

Your Label Amendment Request Dated June 24, 1988

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is not acceptable for the following reasons.

According to our records this product contains Freon 11 and Freon 12. These propellents/solvents have been banned from use as pesticide ingredients. Please refer to PR Notice 78-3 regarding the ban on certain chlorofluorocarbon propellents. You must substitute other acceptable inert ingredient(s) for the Freon 11 and Freon 12. You will need to submit the following information with your inert ingredient substitution request:

1. Application for Amended Registration (EPA Form 8570-11).
2. Confidential Statement of Formula (EPA Form 8570-4).
3. Draft labeling revised to reflect the ingredients statement; precautionary labeling, and use directions of the new formulation.
4. Data on the chemistry of the new formulation as required by Section 162.8 of the Regulations.

You must send us the new application with the substituted inert ingredient(s) within 75 days of receipt of this letter or else the product will be considered withdrawn.

The labeling requires updating as follows:

1. Delete the term "Natural" from your label.
2. List the ingredients in a columnar format.
3. The KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN statement must be placed before the CAUTION signal word.
4. The following statement must be placed under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE heading:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

5. Add the following headings for your Precautionary Statements which begin with the statement "Do not get in eyes . . .":

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

6. Change the statement "All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using" to read "All food processing surfaces and equipment should be covered during treatment or washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse."
7. Include the following heading and statements:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of wastes.

8. Delete the WARNING statement from the chemical hazards portion of your label that begins "WARNING: Contents under pressure" Add the "PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS" heading to this portion of the label.
9. You must have a storage and disposal section on the label that should read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, locked area
away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container
in trash. Do not incinerate or
puncture.
