The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

You must submit the required product chemistry data on your newly formulated pesticide in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 158.190. In addition, submit a new Confidential Statement of Formula with completed results for Blocks / (density), 8 (pH), 9 (Flash point/flame extension), 13a (Amount of component in formulation), and 14 (Certified Limits).

The statement, "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling", should be relocated directly below the Directions for Use heading.

Delete "sesame oil" and "mineral oil" from the active ingredients on your label. Sesame oil, as an active ingredient, is not being supported for reregistration, and the sources for the active ingredient mineral oil are invalid. A reformulation of your product, for this concern, is not necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To Spray: Hold dispenser upright with opening on side of cap over
item to be treated. Press top of cap to release mist. Move 3 feet away
from object to avoid staining. Close doors and windows. Do not
remain in closed treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment
is completed.

Flying Insects: Flies, mosquitoes, biting clothes moths, gnats,
hornets & wasps. Spray towards center of room with a circular
motion. It is not necessary to spray insects directly. For
average 10x10x10 room spray 15 seconds for hornets & wasps,
& 1 to 2 seconds for other insects. Keep room closed for 30
minutes after spraying.

To control fleas, lice on dogs or repeat howlites, gnats on
horses. Spray into base of hair all over animal. Move can
to get even coverage of coat (until tip of hair are moist).
Ruffle long hair in spray to reach skin. Spray ticks directly.
Also apply liberally to floor cracks and crevices.
Animals do not get in eyes.

Repeat all applications as required.

Bed Bugs: Spray thoroughly the dismantled spring, mattress
and frame, giving special attention to all cracks and seams.
Baseboards and wall cracks should be sprayed.

Crawling Insects: Bed bug, water bugs, silverfish, fleas, ants
to dogs. Direct mist into cracks, crevices and recess behind
carpets. Also spray around doors & windows, pet trails &
corners. Keep room closed at least 3 hours for best results.
Repeat as needed.

Clothes Moths: Clean and brush warm materials. Spray thoroughly
all articles to be protected, keeping nozzle 3 feet away to
avoid staining. Spray inside closets and containers thoroughly
before storing. Articles not kept in moth tight containers
should be treated monthly.

Do not get in eyes. If material gets in eyes rinse
with cold clear water and seek medical attention.

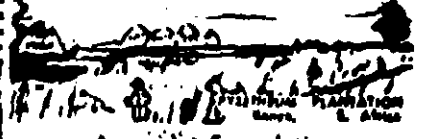

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Use electric unit with enclosed insecticide pads. Only Bug Stop pads will work.
2. Tear seal, take out one pad. Use with the BUG STOP logo facing up.
3. Insert pad between the heater surface and the grill as shown.
4. Plug unit into standard 110 V outlet. --Mosquitos are repelled and destroyed in rooms up to 2,300 cu. ft. (12 X 20 X 8). To extend coverage, just unplug the evaporator and move every hour to another room. Plug back in and continue for another hour. This strategy will protect 8 rooms or 18,400 sq. ft.

One pad lasts up to 8 hours and only needs to be changed when its color changes to white.

5. To change the pad, unplug the unit and insert a new pad as shown -- The used pad will automatically fall out when you push the new pad in.
