## Precautionary Statements - Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

#### Directions for Use - General Classification

In a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, holding the catch. Then dial fogger on stand upright in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or bed under fogger. Leave building alone and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

The spray mist will kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Flies, Flying Moths, Bats, Carpet Beetles, Spiders, Centipedes, Crickets, Silverfish, Firebrats, Bees, Wasps, Hornets, and Ants. Aids in the Control of Cockroaches and Waterbugs.

**TO KILL TICKS:** Spray in all locations where ticks breed and hide. When treatment is completed, treat dogs and cats with a registered tick product prior to re-entry.

**TO KILL FLEAS:** Spray as described above. Use one unit for every 6,000 cubic feet of space.
