DIRECTIONS

When applied as an aerosol with the Carmel Chemical Fog Applicator, Carmel MU-8 is recommended for the control of Cigarette Beetles, and Tobacco Moths in buildings where tobacco is stored; ~~and for control of adult moths, sciarid and dermid fly control in mushroom houses, 5011-77~~

PREPARATION OF THE BUILDING PRIOR TO FOGGING

- (1) Close all doors, windows, and ventilators. (2) Lock or barricade all entrances, turn off pilot lights, post warning signs, and take precautions to prevent persons and animals from entering

the area. (3) Room temperature should read over 70°F. for best insect kill.

FOR CIGARETTE BEETLE OR TOBACCO MOTH CONTROL IN TOBACCO STORAGE ROOMS:

Wear a full-faced gas mask with canister type recommended by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for phosphate insecticide protection.

- (1) Open the metering valve on the Carmel Chemical Fog Applicator counter-clockwise to the No. 1 setting on the dial. Eight ounces of liquid will be fogged per minute with a mass median diameter of 5 microns (eight ounces will treat 24,000 cubic feet of space -- equivalent to one ounce per 3000 cubic feet). Walk backward down the center aisle of the room swaying the machine back and forth to blanket the entire cubical contents of the room. Length of exposure time is 2 hours with windows and doors closed. After this exposure time, the room should be well ventilated -- at least 1 hour before re-entering.

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~~For ADULT MOTHS, SCIARID AND DERMID FLY CONTROL IN MUSHROOM HOUSES, 5011-77~~

~~Wear a full-faced gas mask with canister type recommended by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for phosphate insecticide protection.~~

~~After closing off all pilot lights and air currents, direct fog toward walking backward in the center aisle of the room. Fog at the rate of one ounce of MU-8 for 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep fog nozzle of fog applicator away from beds. Do not allow fog to fall on mushroom beds within 10 feet from the end of the gun. Use during~~

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~~spawn run twice weekly to prevent fly build-up. This surface~~
~~use as required. Length of exposure time should be limited to~~
~~1 hour; then open the doors and exhaust fog as you would ventilate.~~
~~Use fans, to ventilate, in those houses which do not have forced~~
~~circulation to assist in removing the fog.~~

FOG APPLICATOR NOTICE

Flush the insecticide tank of the Carmel Fog Applicator immediately after each use otherwise residue from the formulation may remain in the tank and insecticide system and block the system completely causing reduced fog output and poor insect control. Flushing immediately after using is a complete answer to this problem.

TO FLUSH:

1. Drain insecticide tank. (To avoid draining tank after fogging, pour in only required amount of insecticide and use it all in the fogging operation.)
2. Pour at least 8 oz. Carmel Flushing Solution (FS-10) into tank. (Fuel oil may be used if flushing solution is not available.)
3. Replace tank cap and apply heat to loosen any residue.
4. Start machine (engine) and fog until tank is empty.
5. Loosen insecticide tank cap to relieve pressure.
6. Remove chemical filter and rinse in gasoline.

After flushing the Carmel Fog Applicator clean engine tailpipe with tailpipe brush and clean inside with special cleanout rod.

CAUTION

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Do not apply within 1 day of harvest of mushrooms.

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Antidotes: If swallowed: Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Call a physician immediately!

WARNING: Poisonous by skin contact, inhalation, or swallowing.

Rapidly absorbed through skin. If on skin, wash immediately with ~~soap and water. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.~~ In case of contact, immediately remove all contaminated clothing and flush skin or eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.

For eyes, get medical attention. Do not breathe fog or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothes. Crepine is antidotal. Keep away from heat and open flame. Always wear a gas mask of a type recommended by the U. S. Bureau of Agriculture for phosphate insecticide protection. Turn off all pilot lights before fogging. Extinguish all pilot lights prior to fogging.

NOTICE: Rinse equipment and disposal of wastes by carrying in non-crop lands water supplies. Containers should be disposed by puncturing holes in them and burying with manure, or by burning (keep away).
