

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of State and Federal laws to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Burrowing pocket gophers (*Thomomys* sp. and *Geomys* sp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a longhanded spoon carefully remove the earth plug from lateral tunnels on fresh mounds. Insert tablespoon quantity of bait to main runway with a long handled spoon. Cover opening so as to exclude light and loose dirt. The main runway may also be located by probing with a sharpened stick or metal rod about 8-18 inches back from the plug mark in the mound. When runway is found, enlarge hole to put in bait as before. Close hole or cover hole so as to exclude light. Be careful to keep bait clean. After 48 hours, scrape over mounds and treat those still active. One pound of bait will treat five to eight acres.
