GRN 61-2, which ORCO submitted, was assigned the MRID No. 42365901. GRNs 62-3 and 171-2, for which APHIS recently submitted new data and for which you have authorization to access, were assigned MRID Nos. 42400505 and 42400507, respectively. You cited old APHIS MRID Nos. for GRNs 61-1 and 62-2, although APHIS has not allowed you to access this confidential information. 
