DIRECTIONS

For the control of horn flies and the reduction of lice on beef cattle with the WIK Applicator and other cattle oilers. Dilute one gallon of this product with four gallons of kerosene before placing it in the insecticide applicator, cattle oiler reservoir, saturating cloth, burlap, cotton, felt or oiler parts. The oiler should be located where cattle loaf or congregate so that they may have access to it at all times.
