DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

To Repel Horn Flies and Face Flies: Use the TOX-O-WIK II Face Applicator and the TOX-O-WIK II Face Applicator. Dilute one gallon of this product with four gallons of kerosene before placing in the applicator reservoir. The applicators should be located where the livestock loaf or congregate so they may have access to it at all times.

To Kill Flies, Flying Moths, Gnats, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, Sandflies and Wasps: Close doors and windows and direct spray upward into the room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray for 30 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Hold nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacuum room after. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-occupancy and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Ants, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Firebrats, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around doors and pipes and other hiding places, hit directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails near windows and door sills and other locations as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping areas of pets, around baseboards, window frames, wall cracks and local areas of infestation. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray a new fresh bedding in pet's quarters after treatment has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.
