

DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, LEATHER, ACETATE, ORLON, DACRON, RAYON, NATURAL SPONGE OR UNFAST COLORS

AS A DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER or CLEANSER

REFRIGERATORS, BASINS, BATHTUBS, FLOORS: Wash thoroughly—keep wet with solution of 3 tablespoons of Launder Maid Bleach to each quart of water. Let stand 5 minutes—rinse-dry.

DISHES, GLASSWARE, POTS, JARS: Use same as above — except use only 1 tablespoon of Launder Maid Bleach to each quart of warm water.

TOILET BOWLS: Wash-flush-pour 1 cup (8 ounces) of Launder Maid Bleach into bowl, apply solution over all inside surfaces, add one ounce of vinegar and let stand one hour or overnight.

SWIMMING POOLS: Amount Launder Maid Bleach required depends on bathing load and other factors. Sufficient Launder Maid Bleach solution should be used daily. Launder Maid Bleach can be poured directly into the Swimming Pool or fed through mechanical Chlorinators. To each 1,000 gallons water, use 5 oz. Launder Maid Bleach. If bathing load is heavy or day is hot, give dosage in morning and again in evening. Maintain chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1 ppm. Use test kit. Maintain the acidity (pH) of the water according to recommendations of the local Health Authority

SICK ROOM DISINFECTANT: To disinfect and deodorize urinals, sputum cups, rubber goods and other equipment, wash-immerses in solution of 3 tablespoonfuls of Launder Maid Bleach to each quart of hot water—let stand 5 minutes—rinse-dry.

TO REMOVE SPOTS AND STAINS —SUCH AS INK, WINE, BERRY, NICOTINE, COFFEE, GRASS, FRUITS, SCORCH, TEA, BLOOD, IODINE, MILDEW

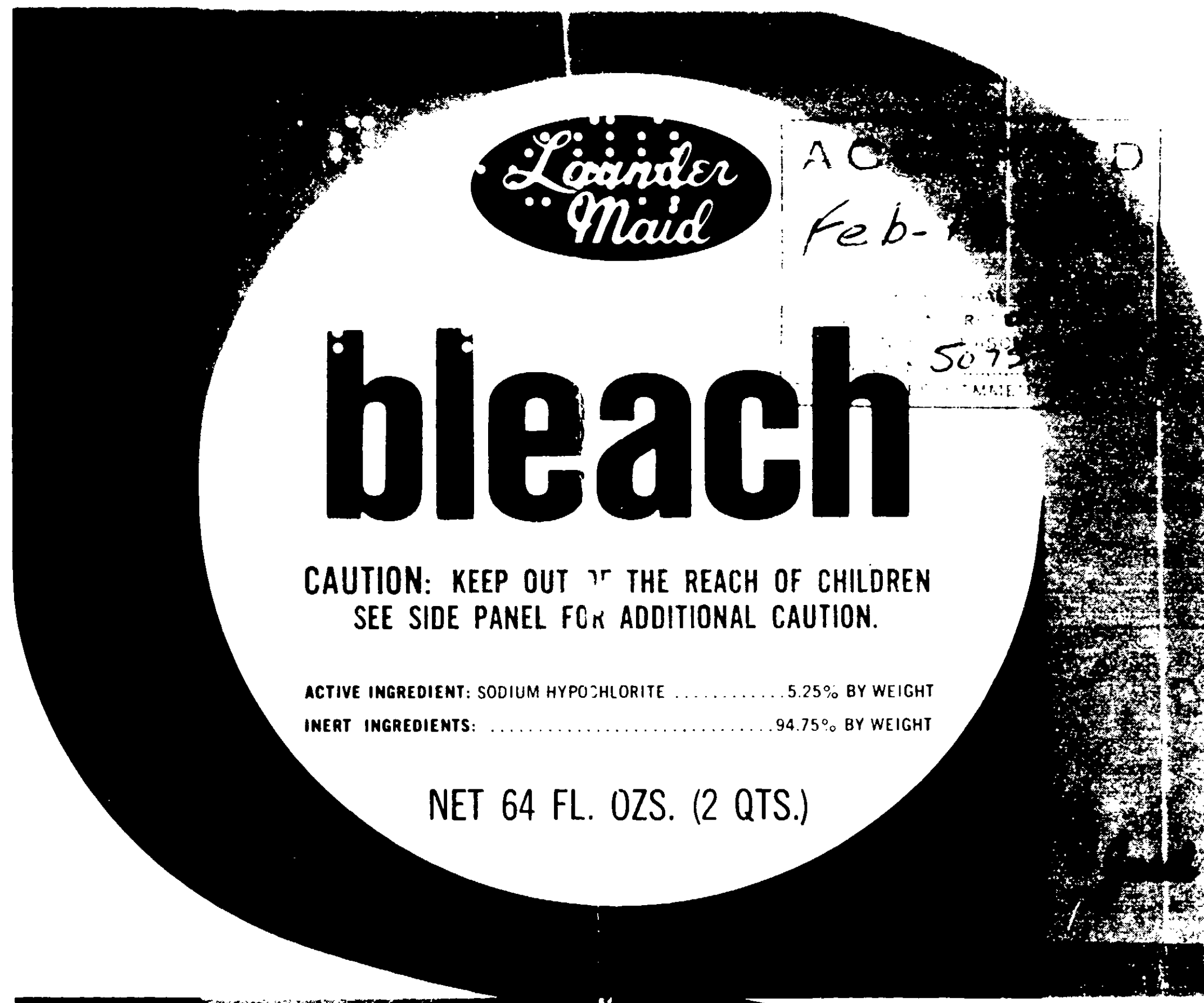
First remove starch or dressing from white cotton and linen garments by soaking in cold water. Make a solution of two tablespoons of Launder Maid Bleach to one quart of cold water—mix well. Immerse fabric completely and soak from 10 to 15 minutes—rinse in clear water. Should any sign of mildew remain, allow it to dry in sunlight. Any remaining brown spots usually vanish with vinegar or lemon juice.

RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, SODA FOUNTAINS, DAIRIES, ETC.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drain board to air dry.

SAFE FOR NYLONS (C)

LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE or AUTOMATIC WASHER

Launder Maid bleaches white cotton, linen and nylon; brightens color-fast cotton and linen; disinfects, deodorizes, removes dingy grayness and stains. Launder Maid Bleach is especially valuable for laundering articles subject to germ contamination, such as diapers.

WHITE COTTONS AND LINENS Launder Maid Bleach is best used in First Rinse after washing—add one tablespoon (1/2 oz.) of Launder Maid Bleach for each gallon of warm water, then immerse clothes for 15 min.—rinse in cold water.
For Automatic Washers — mix one ounce of Launder Maid Bleach for each gallon of water and pour slowly at wash period.

In Soak suds add 1 tablespoon Launder Maid Bleach for each gallon cold or warm water, mix well, add soap or sudsing powder, immerse clothes 1/2 hour to overnight.

BABY'S LAUNDRY Use same as above. Diapers, sheets and rubber garments laundered with Launder Maid Bleach are hospital clean and fresh smelling.

FAST COLORED GARMENTS Use only 1/2 tablespoon Launder Maid Bleach for each gallon of water.
