**THIRAM 75 is insoluble in water and may tend to settle out unless agitated. In order to keep THIRAM 75 in suspension, constant agitation is necessary. THIRAM 75 will pass through a 200 mesh screen.**

**CAUTION:** Do not get on eyes, skin, clothing. May be harmful if inhaled or swallowed. May cause skin irritation. This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of waste.

**ANTIDOTE:** In the event of skin contact, wash with water; if material comes in contact with eyes, wash out with water and call doctor.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

THIRAM 75 is a wettable powder fungicide, that has proved to be effective both in the prevention and cure of various grass diseases such as Dollar Spot, Brown Patch and Snow Mold (Fusarium).

**PREVENTIVE:** For Dollar Spot and Brown Patch: Use 3 oz per 1000 sq. ft. at 7 days intervals from April to September

For Snow Mold: use 8 oz per 1000 sq. ft. late in fall, before first snow. Spring: use 3 oz per 1000 sq. ft. as soon as snow thaws.

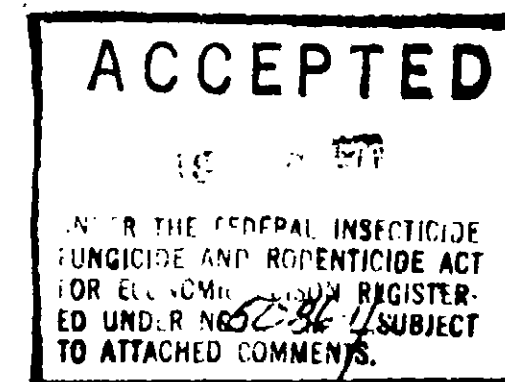
**CURATIVE:** For Dollar Spot and Brown Patch use 6 oz per 1000 sq. ft.

**AMOUNT OF WATER:** 5 gals of water per 1000 sq. ft. will usually give adequate coverage.

**CANADIAN USER:** For Imperial gallons, use 20 % more THIRAM 75.

During weather favorable to fungus disease (rainy or damp days) it may be necessary to spray every 3 to 5 days.
