

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use on floors, countertops, sinks, tubs, toilet bowls or other environmental hard surfaces to clean, deodorize and disinfect. Suitable for use on linoleum tile, porcelain, stainless steel, aluminum, ceramic tile, glass or finished wood surfaces.

For Cleaning, prepare a solution of 1/4 cup per gallon of water. Apply with a sponge, mop or towel. Rinse or mop up to remove soil.

For Disinfection, preclean as described above then reapply 1/4 cup per gallon solution to thoroughly wet all surfaces to be disinfected. Allow contact for 10 minutes before rinsing or mop up.

For Disinfecting and Deodorizing Toilet Bowls, preclean as above then add 1/4 cup to clear, clean bowl water and use a bowl mop to wet all surfaces, especially under the rim. Let stand 10 minutes before flushing.

For Deodorizing Clothes, pour 1/4 cup in the rinse water. Clothes will come out smelling fresh and clean. Do not use on diapers.

Storage and Disposal. Store only in tightly closed container in an area inaccessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse with water and discard in trash.
