DISPOSE OF WASTES by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Container should be disposed of by burying with wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dust the under surface of leaves as well as top surface. Apply this dust when insects first appear. Repeat applications weekly, or as often as necessary, throughout the growing season.

BEANS (SNAP AND LIMA): For Control of Mexican Bean Beetle, Flea Beetle, Cucumber Beetle, Leaf Beetle and Aphid: Apply 1/2 lb. of dust per 1,000 sq. ft. when insects are first noted and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals.

ASPARAGUS: For Control of Asparagus Beetle and Japanese Beetle: Apply 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. when insects are first noted and repeat in 7 to 10 days.

CABBAGE: For Control of Cabbage Looper and Flea Beetle: Apply 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. when insects are first noted and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals, as needed.

ORNAMENTAL TREES, SHRUBS AND FLOWERS: For Control of Japanese Beetle: Make first application when insects are noted. Repeat as often as necessary to control insects. Use 1/2 to 3/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. of planted area.

STRAWBERRIES: For Control of Spittlebug, Flea Beetle and Leaf Beetle: Apply 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Make first application early in Spring for Spittlebug control, and repeat every 7 to 10 days as necessary. For Flea Beetle and Leaf Beetle, apply when insects are noted and repeat in 7 to 10 days, as necessary, for control.

GRAPES, BLUEBERRIES, RASPBERRIES, BLACKBERRIES AND DEWBERRIES: For Control of Japanese Beetle: Apply when insects are first noted and repeat in 7 to 10 days. For Control of Raspberry Cane Borer: Apply to foliage just before plants bloom and repeat in 7 to 10 days. Use 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft.

DOGS AND CATS: For Control of Fleas: Apply dust liberally to entire animal. Repeat at weekly intervals, as necessary for control.

FLEA CONTROL IN ANIMAL QUARTERS: For control of Fleas in Kennels, Pans, Yards, Farms and homes: Use at a rate of 4 to 6 ounces per 100 sq. ft. Apply with a hand sprayer. Do not spray near animals before dusting.
