DoBois SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER is a water-soluble, non-toxic, non-irritant, non-flammable, non-corrosive, and non-volatile liquid.

Soiled and contaminated fabric, such as diapers, hospital and institutional linen, and athletic equipment, of major bacteriostatic concern not only in hospitals, but in institutions, hotels, restaurants, and schools. Used as directed, DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER provides effective residual bacteriostatic and self-sanitizing properties for laundered items such as diapers, hospital and institutional linen, and athletic equipment. For residual bacteriostatic or self-sanitizing activity, conditions of high relative humidity and contamination are required. DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER is designed for commercial and institutional laundry use by addition to the final rinse step. Laundered fabric may also be treated by soaking in a solution of DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER. For recommended solution concentration, see the Directions.

DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER is economical to use because it is concentrated. It should be diluted before use.

USING DIRECTIONS:

General Classification: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For residual bacteriostatic and self-sanitizing properties, use DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER as directed.

For residual bacteriostatic activity against *Staphylococcus aureus*, ATCC No. 4352 and *Staphylococcus aureus* ATCC No. 6538, use 4 fluid oz. per 100 lbs. of fabric (dry weight).

For residual self-sanitizing activity against *Staphylococcus aureus*, ATCC No. 4352 and *Staphylococcus aureus* ATCC No. 6538, use 4 fluid oz. DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER per 100 lbs. of fabric (dry weight).

Please use appropriate caution when using DOBOIS SUPER LAUNDRY BACTERIOSTAT-SANITIZER in one-to-one dilution of concentration of the product in the final rinse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsions may be needed.

Environmental Hazards - This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with RPD5 permit. For guidance contact your Regional Office of the EPA.

Physical Hazards - Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

Storage and Disposal

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Open dumping is prohibited.
- Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide Disposal - Pesticide that cannot be used, or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Container Disposal - Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers. Bury in a safe place or return to dealer for reconditioning.
