

DE VERE HELP SANITIZER

HELP is a sanitizer for the last tank. HELP leaves no film on glasses. The rich creamy head on beer lasts longer when HELP is used in the last tank. Even on the first glass of beer, a collar of foam remains after each swallow. Glasses will drain perfectly and there will be no water spotting. When used as directed, HELP is tasteless and odorless.

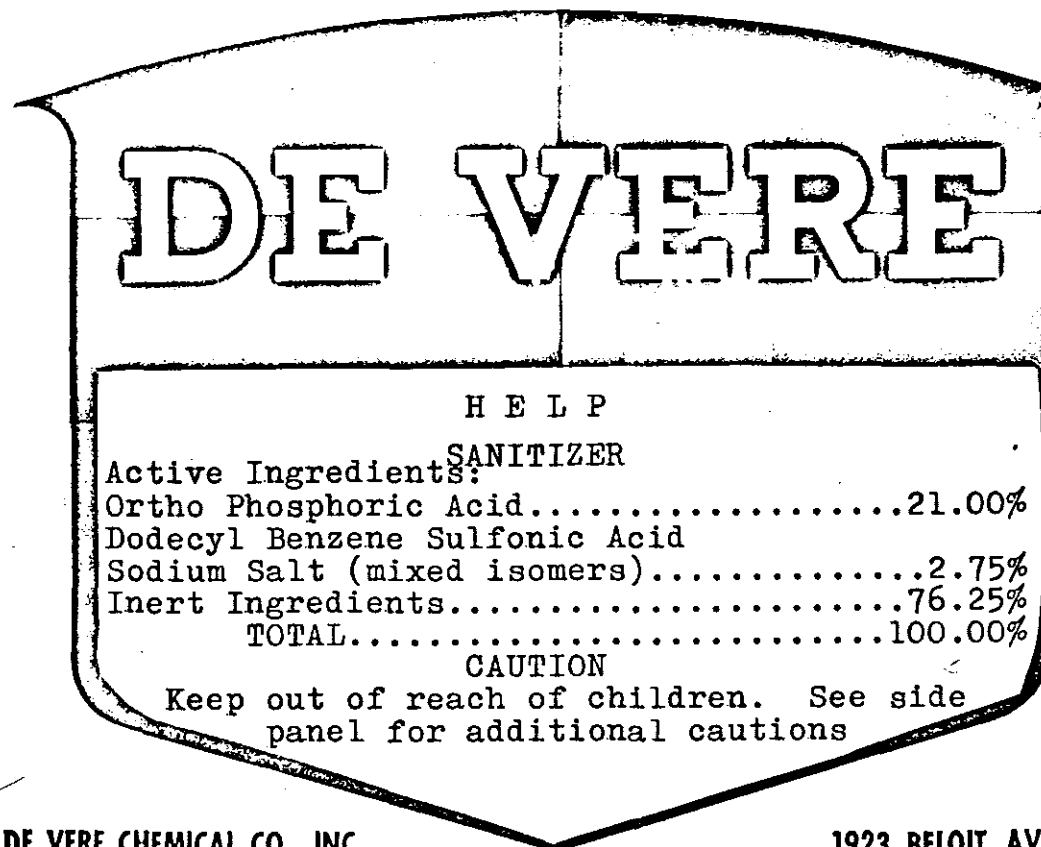

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible
2. Wash with De Vere LIME SOLVENT.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 oz. HELP to 1 gallon of water (200 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes, or for contact times specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

1st TANK WASH	2nd TANK RINSE	3rd TANK SANITIZE
1 oz LIME SOLVENT to 4 gal water	Clear Water	Required amount of HELP Sanitizer

1 oz. HELP to 1 gallon of water provides 200 ppm.

CAUTION: Avoid contamination of food. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. Use only in stainless steel tanks. Do not mix with chlorine solutions.
