

This is in response to the Material Safety Data Sheet, the revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and labeling submitted in support of the reclassification of Dodecylbenzenesulfonic acid (DDBSA) as an active ingredient.

The revised CSF agrees with the label and is acceptable. The subject product is in compliance with the current EPA Label Improvement Program.

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act is acceptable subject to the following comments. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

- 1) The statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal" should be placed directly below the Storage and Disposal heading.
- 2) The full product name should be used all through the label, where reference is made to the name.
- Delete "When used as directed, HELP is tasteless and 3) odorless."


