Help Sanitizer
EPA Registration No. 5174-11

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Revise the precautionary statement as following:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

Danger: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

Revised the statement of practical treatment as follows:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

The following statement must appear separate from, but in close proximity to the statement of practical treatment.


Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

2. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

LEFT PANEL**DE VERE HELP SANITIZER**

HELP SANITIZER is a sanitizer for the last tank. HELP SANITIZER leaves no film on glasses. The rich creamy head on beer lasts longer when HELP SANITIZER is used in the last tank. Even on the first glass of beer, a collar of foam remains after each swallow. Glasses will drain perfectly and there will be no water spotting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with De Vere LIME SOLVENT.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 3/4 oz. HELP SANITIZER to 1 gallon of water. Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes, or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
