Blow out the flame and allow coil to smolder until extinguished. For shorter periods of use, break coil into desired length. Place on non-combustible surface and keep lighted coils away from flammable materials, surfaces or objects. For best results evenly space coils approximately 8-10 feet apart around perimeter of area to be protected. Cover exposed food to avoid contamination. Save the stands for future use.



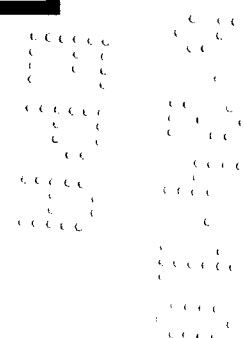
Gently flex and separate interlocked coils.
