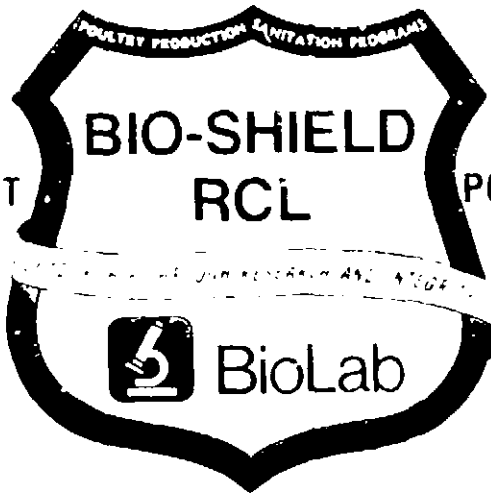

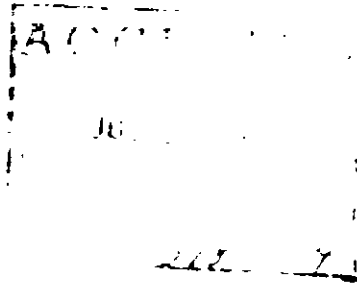

**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING HATCHERY EQUIPMENT
IN AUTOMATED SYSTEMS**

1. Turn off power to the automated system.
2. Remove all eggs and chicks from the system.
3. Fill the system with a solution of 1 part disinfectant to 100 parts water.
4. Allow the solution to remain in the system for 30 minutes.
5. Drain the system and rinse thoroughly with clean water.
6. Repeat the process as often as necessary to maintain a sanitary environment.

**SANITIZING HATCHER TRAYS, RACKS, PLASTIC CHICK BOXES, CRATES,
PLASTIC EGG FLATS, ETC.**

1. Wash the equipment with clean water.
2. Dip the equipment into a solution of 1 part disinfectant to 100 parts water.
3. Allow the equipment to remain in the solution for 30 minutes.
4. Rinse the equipment thoroughly with clean water.
5. Dry the equipment completely before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR HATCHING EGG PROCESSING

1. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water before handling eggs.
2. Place eggs in a clean, sanitized container.
3. Add the required amount of disinfectant to the water in the container.
4. Allow the eggs to remain in the solution for the required time.
5. Remove the eggs and rinse them thoroughly with clean water.
6. Dry the eggs completely before hatching.

DISINFECTING EGG PROCESSING EQUIPMENT

1. Wash the equipment with clean water.
2. Dip the equipment into a solution of 1 part disinfectant to 100 parts water.
3. Allow the equipment to remain in the solution for 30 minutes.
4. Rinse the equipment thoroughly with clean water.
5. Dry the equipment completely before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store near food or feed. Dispose of unused product in accordance with local regulations.
