SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER kills all types of pool algae. When used as directed, SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER will rid your pool of unsightly algae spots.

#### DIRECTIONS

The pH of the pool water should be adjusted to 7.4 - 7.6 before applying SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER.

Shut off filter pump, brush wall-clinging algae vigorously, then allow pool water to become stationary. When the pool is not in use (preferably at night), sprinkle SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER where algae growth appears, both along pool walls and over surface of water. For heavy algae growth use 14 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water. For light algae growth, use 7 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water. Turn on pump after six hours. Do not use pool until chlorine residual falls below 3 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.

Twelve to twenty-four hours after treatment, remove dead algae growths by brushing or scraping. If visible, living algae is still present after brushing, repeat treatment with SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER.

DO NOT USE Spot Kill Super Algae Destroyer in painted, vinyl lined, fiberglass or colored plaster surface pools.

**DANGER: Keep Out Of Reach Of Children.** Corrosive, causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. May cause burns to broken skin. Wear goggles or face shield and protective clothing when handling. Wash hands after handling.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT (First Aid):** If swallowed, feed gruel, cooked cereal, or bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil. In case of personal contact, remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical attention as soon as possible. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**CHEMICAL HAZARDS.** Strong oxidizing agent. Do not use moist or damp utensils. Contamination with moisture, dirt, organic matter or other chemicals or any other foreign matter may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases and possible generation of fire.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into public waters. For guidance contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open area if possible, and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.

#### TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY:

Rectangular Pools — length times width times depth in feet times 7.5 equals gallons.

Round and Oval Pools — Long diameter times short diameter times average depth in feet times 5.9 equals gallons.
