

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be father swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear-goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance contact the regional office of EPA.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMCIAL HAZARDS STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Strong Oxidizing Agent. Mix only with water Use clear, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing devine containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a che nical reaction, with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible gerieration of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECT:ONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

The pH of the pool water should be adjusted to 7.4 ± 7.6 before applying SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER.

Shut off filter pump, brush wall-clinging algae vigorously, then allow pool water to become stationary. When the pool is not in use (preferably at night), sprinkle SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROY-ER where algae growth appears both along walls and over surface of water. For heavy algae growth, use 2 pounds per 10,000 gals, of water. For light algae growth, use 1 pound per 10,000 gals, of water. Turn on pump after six hours. Co not use pool until chlorine residual falls below 3 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.

Twenty to twenty-four hours after treatment, remove dead algae growth by brushing or scraping. If visible, living algae is still present after brushing, repeat treatment with SPOT KILL SUPER ALGAE DESTROYER.

DO NOT USE Spot Kill Super Algae Destroyer in painted, vinyl fined, fillerglass or colored plaster surface pools.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in fightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well verifiated area away from heat or open flame, in case of decomposition iscitate container, if possible, and flood with large amount of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved lanofill area, or bury in a safe place.

TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY: Pectangular Pools — length limes width times depth (in feet) times 75 equals gallons. Pound and Oval Pools — Long diameter times short diameter times assigned depth (in feet) times 59 counts called a
