This product is an effective algicide for the control of growth of algae and slime in swimming pools. BIO-GUARD SWIMMING POOL ALGICIDE 28-50 is effective in all types of water; is readily soluble and spreads rapidly throughout the pool and is non-corrosive to pools and equipment.

This algicide is compatible with all chemicals normally used in swimming pool maintenance, however, in its concentrated form this chemical should not come in contact with high concentrations of chlorine. **DO NOT MIX ALGICIDE AND CHLORINE TOGETHER WHEN ADDING TO THE POOL.**

DIRECTIONS

For initial application or when pool water is changed, use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water. If algae are visible at time of first treatment, use one quart per 15,000 gallons, followed by re-application after algae have died or withered (if 14 days or more after application use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water. After a period of consequence, use one quart per 25,000 gallons of water in addition to the above amounts.

This algicide may be added by pouring directly into the pools. Recirculation or swimming activity will disperse the algicide. More rapid dispersion may be achieved by pouring a little of the correct amount into several areas of the pool.

WARNING! Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If swallowed, call a physician. Remove and wash off contaminated clothing. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Do not discharge into lakes, streams or ponds.

TO DETERMINE POOL CAPACITY

RECTANGULAR POOLS: Length x width times average depth (in feet) times 7.5 = gallons.

ROUND AND OVAL POOLS: Long diameter times short diameter times average depth (in feet) times 3.14 = gallons.
