**DIRECTIONS**

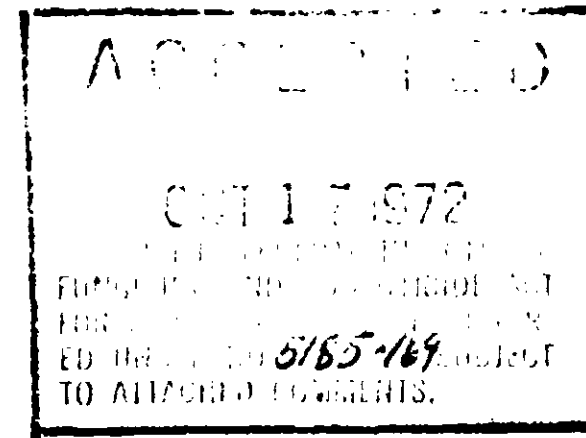
