inanimate environmental surfaces.

This product may be used for disinfecting and sanitizing hard surfaces, such as
cleaned non-porous inanimate hard surfaces.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact immediately flush eyes or
skin with plenty of water at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician.
Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

solution or if these are not available, drink a large quantity of water. Avoid

SANITIZATION

**Sanitizing Dairy Equipment, Milk Cans, Glassware, Silverware,
Dishes, Cooking Utensils, etc.** Pre-clean the item with a san-
itizing solution of 1 oz. to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm) for 2
minutes. Then on a rack or drainboard and air dry. Invert milk
cans to clean surface to drain and air dry. Do not use a towel.

Sanitizing Equipment in Food & Meat Processing Plants: Pre-
clean then wet all surfaces thoroughly with a sanitizing solution
of 1 oz. to 4 gallons water (400 ppm) by flooding or spraying.
Allow contact of 2 minutes, then rinse equipment with potable
water before reuse.

Flank and Udder Wash

Use a washing solution of 1 oz. per 4 gallons of water. Use a
fresh towel for each cow. Wring towel well and use it to dry the
teats and udder before attaching to inflations. Do not return
used towel to the wash solution. Do not reuse washing solution.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap con-
tainer and put in trash collection.
